MSSC is a Joint Venture Company of the Light Vehicle Systems business group of ArvinMeritor. ArvinMeritor has a 57% interest, with the remaining 43% interest belonging to Mitsubishi Steel Manufacturing Company of Japan.

MSSC was founded in 1895, as Dowsley Spring and Axle, going through various name changes over the past 110+ years. Some of these name changes include: Ontario Steel Products, Rockwell, Meritor and ArvinMeritor.

MSSC has been affiliated with the CAW (formerly UAW) since 1943.

MSSC is located in a 167, 000 square foot building on Park Ave. in Chatham.

MSSC produces stabilizer bars and torsion bars. MSSC is the sole supplier of all torsion bars in North America. MSSC also has an Assembly department, assembling bushings and brackets on stabilizer bars.

Presently, the CAW Local 127 workforce consists of 178 Production workers and 25 Skilled Trades workers, for a total workforce of 203.
