Following a Unit Meeting last week, I am following up with a brief update.

Prescription Drug Coverage

The Company has advised the Union Leadership that there will be a change of the Provider for Prescription Drugs. Greenshield is currently the provider of this service to Navistar Unit retirees and for those who are currently laid-off and purchasing this benefit from the Company. On May 1, 2011 the Prescription Drug provider will be Claim Secure. There will be no change in regard to the fees; they will remain as denoted in the collective agreement which expired June 29, 2009. New cards will be issued by Claim Secure to all retirees and to laid-off Members currently purchasing benefit coverage from the Company.

Unit Meeting Follow-Up

As stated at the Unit Meeting on February 13, 2011, the Union was awaiting a response from Dan Ustian to Ken Lewenza. Contact has been made this past week and the Company has committed to arranging a meeting between Union Leadership and an assigned party from the Company to further discuss the situation at the Chatham Assembly Plant.
