

C.A.W. LOCAL 127 NOTICE

Brothers & Sisters:

As you know, the Executive Board of Local 127 at the June 22, 2009 meeting recommended the selling of our building. This was done through a series of meetings.

On June 23, 2009 we called a meeting to address this issue, and subsequently, a motion to table this recommendation was voted on and passed. Once a motion to table was supported and passed, it ended all debate, so now we must meet again.

Since the month of July is a "Historic" down month because of holidays for most of our units, we have called two different meetings for Sunday Aug 30th 2009 and Monday Aug 31st, 2009 to discuss and vote on:

- 1) The potential sale of Caw Local 127 building
- 2) Dues Supplement.

We want to be clear as possible, we have to put dues supplement on the agenda as the current dues structure and our current membership level can not maintain our building.

We can not support the dues supplement as we have many units working short work weeks, down weeks, and work share programs.

Our Executive Board's decision is to sell the building as this is the only reasonable answer to the financial crisis facing our local today.

To clarify who can vote, all members, ALL members in good standing (active and laid-off) can vote. A laid off member in good standing means that they have active recall rights. They can vote on both motions.

The retirees can vote ONLY to sell the Hall, they can not vote on dues supplement, as this can only be voted on by active members.

We urge your participation for these upcoming meetings, and Please remember to bring your union card as there will be a check off at the door, and also for voting purposes.
